Pū'ōhala Elementary School is a designated site for Hawaiian Language Immersion Program (HLIP) summer school for students in Pre-Kindergarten through Post-5th Grade.

<u>ALL STUDENTS MAY APPLY.</u> Hawaiian language background is **NOT** required. Please be advised of the following information about the summer school program.

Summer School Dates and Time:

Monday, June 5th through, Monday July 3rd, 2023 from 7:45 am - 2:15 pm. NO SCHOOL : Monday, June 12th Lā Kamehameha

Registration:

When your application is received by us, a confirmation of enrollment will be sent to the e-mail address provided on the application, unless otherwise indicated. If you do not hear from us within one (1) week, please contact us at the phone number or email listed at the top.

Fees:

Tuition is free for all Hawaii DOE students. \$190 for non-Hawaii DOE students (checks payable to Kula Kaiapuni 'o Ānuenue).

Tuition refund schedule:

Withdraw by 5/31 (3 days before instruction starts) - 100% refund (\$190) Withdraw by 6/2 (1 day before instruction starts) - 50% refund (\$95) Withdraw by 6/9 (by 5th day of instruction) - 25% refund (\$47.50)

Attendance:

The student is expected to maintain good attendance and punctuality throughout the entire summer session. Parents/Guardians should give consideration to family activities such as trips and/or vacations that may interfere with summer school before enrolling your child.

In case of an absence, the summer school should be called between 7:45 am and 8:15 am.

Grade Reports & Evaluations:

Students will be issued a report card at the end of the summer session.

Meals:

Lunches need to be provided for each student. In the past we were fortunate to have free hot lunches, if this situation should arise again this summer we will notify you as soon as possible.

Rules & Regulations:

Students are expected to maintain acceptable standards of good conduct and discipline as in the regular school setting. The rules and regulations pertaining to discipline of students are set by the Department of Education and will be implemented and maintained. The rules and regulations of Pū'ōhala Elementary School will prevail in areas not specified by the Department of Education.

Class Cancellations:

Summer school is supported entirely by enrollment, therefore, classes may be canceled due to insufficient enrollment.
